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Wintertime Farmers' Market Vendor Information

Wintertime Market Fees

Fees allow us to pay for market insurance, maintenance, market management, printing costs, events at the markets and publicity.

Vendors can pay by season, by month or by week. Here are the fees per 8ft table:

Season Fee (Dec-Apr): \$250 due at the beginning of the season.

Monthly Fee: \$50/month due at the beginning of a month.

Weekly Fee: \$15/week due each week.

Market Standards

Our goal is to foster markets with a diversity of locally grown and produced foods that are accessible to all segments of the population and unrivaled in quality and freshness.

- **Fresh produce:** Over the course of the farmers' market season, 60% of what you sell must be grown on your own farm. 100% must be sourced from farms in RI, MA, or CT. We encourage the display of the farm and state of the purchased food.
- **Artisinal products:** Foods should be crafted in RI, MA or CT and ideally be made with ingredients originating from family farms in New England. We encourage the display of the farm and state origins.
- **Prepared foods:** Prepared foods should strive to use ingredients grown in RI and the New England region. Vendors of prepared foods must sell at least one such item. We encourage the display of the farm and state origins.
- **Attendance:** Please plan to arrive at the market by 10:15am. Please call the market manager in the case of an unplanned absence or delay, as soon as you know. Jen's cell is 529-4952 and Sheri's cell is 480-0102. The American Locomotive Works facility has contract service for snow plowing and so the market will be open barring a heavy winter storm during market hours.
- **Vendor Areas:** Please bring your own 8ft table, tablecloth and display supplies to set up in the area designated by the market manager. We encourage vendors to bring signage for their table with their farm or business name/logo and town you are based in. Vendors are responsible for making sure the area around their tables are as clean after the market as when they arrived.
- **Product Insurance:** Vendors selling food products other than fresh fruits and vegetables must carry product liability insurance and appropriate licensing from the RI or MA Department of Health.

Failure to comply with these standards degrades the market and will jeopardize participation.
